

BASKET WEAVING

Adults and children can learn to make their own baskets using a variety of techniques and materials. Every culture has developed some kind of basketry based on the plants that grow in the local environment. Baskets for gathering and storing food, for carrying everything from babies to fuel, for catching fish and for many other uses allowed human civilization to advance. In these beginning classes we will make "flat reed" baskets from commercially available rattan "reed", personalizing your project by adding colors and other embellishments. All necessary tools will be provided.

CHAIN MAILLE CLASSES- Learn to make your own chain jewelry using a 3,000 year-old art of chain maille, metal rings linked together in a pattern. "Chain" refers to a series of links which create a chain and "maille" means mesh. Chain maille is quite versatile, using metal jump rings you can weave a pattern creating a length or a mesh fabric. Once you know some basic weaves you can mix weaves, add beads or charms and make it all your own.
