# WICOMICO SHORES GOLF COURSE



**W**icomico Shores Golf Course is an 18-hole course owned and operated by St. Marys County Government. The base of operations, the Clubhouse, is sited on a hill overlooking the expansive course and the scenic Wicomico River.

*The generously sized course greens,* level fairways and variety of hole designs will provide a challenge to players of all abilities and is enjoyed by both walkers and riders. Par for the course is 72 for all, with back tees measuring 6,397 yards with a slope of 125 and a course rating of 70.3. Yardage for the middle tees is 6,110, sloped at 69.0 and rated 123. The forward tees are rated 69.6 and sloped at 118, and are 5,320 yards in length.

Bermuda grass conversion made Wicomico's fairways even more enjoyable and drought tolerant. The Course is constantly being enhanced and improved by the latest technology in ground and greens maintenance.

The newly renovated clubhouse sits on the top of the hillside with a spectacular view of the course and the Wicomico River. Facilities include an elegant banquet room, friendly grille room, offices, fully stocked Golf Pro Shop, and cart storage.

*The Wicomico Shores Golf Course* was constructed in the late 1960's as the anchor for the Wicomico Shores residential development. The Course was expanded in 1980 to an 18-hole facility totaling 145 acres. In 1987, Wicomico Incorporated donated the Golf Course to St. Mary's County Government. Since then, Recreation & Parks has successfully managed the self-supporting operation under the direction of Golf Course Manager Pat Meyers, PGA/LPGA Golf Professional, James Farren, GCSAA Golf Course Superintendent.



Group and individual outings can be booked ahead depending availability. Formal and informal league play can be enjoyed by novice or experienced players.

The Wicomico Shores Golf Advisory Board advise The Board of County Commissioners on future planning, development, fees, policies, and related issues of golf course management.

The Wicomico Shores recreational complex also boasts a public boat ramp and 150-foot fishing pier, both strategically located on the beautiful Wicomico River.
