ELIGIBILITY: Open to any business or organization based within St Mary's County and County residents, which have demonstrated outstanding efforts to improve the environment. Recognition may be granted for voluntary initiatives, projects or for efforts exceeding regulatory requirements within the past calendar year (Jan-Dec 2020).

SCOPE OF THE AWARDS: Examples of programs and projects include, but are not limited to:

- Use of integrated pest management to minimize the use of chemical pesticides and herbicides
- Composting food scraps, yard waste
- Pollution prevention and green purchasing
- Reduction of waste, increase reuse and recycling efforts
- Implementation of projects to encourage alternative transportation
- Expansion and protection of green space for natural and recreational uses
- Protection and enhancement of wildlife and habitats
- Installation of energy and water conservation measures
- · Native tree planting and management
- Invasive species management projects
- Stream monitoring and restoration programs

- Promoting neighborhood stewardship of local natural resources
- Pollinator protection
- Environmental education programs
- Creation of baseline information on quality and quantity of natural resources
- Pursuance of green building (LEED standards) in public and private development
- Proper pet waste and litter disposal
- Environmental Management Systems
- Greenhouse gas emissions reductions
- Generation of or purchase of alternative energy
- Improving aged septic systems and drain fields
- Innovative environmental enhancement ideas or projects
