NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of County Commissioners for St. Mary's County will hold a Public Hearing on March 1, 2011 at 11:30 a.m. in the Chesapeake Building located at 41770 Baldrige Street, Leonardtown, Maryland to consider an ordinance granting a property tax credit against the county property tax imposed on real property for real property that is owned by Habitat for Humanity with the intention of relinquishing ownership in the immediate future and used exclusively for the purpose of rehabilitation and transfer to a private owner, pursuant to the *Property Tax Article §9-252 of the Annotated Code of Maryland*. Citizens are encouraged to attend and participate in the public hearing.

Note that as a result of the evidence and comments made at the public hearing, amendments may be made to the proposed ordinance.
