Chairman Hall called the meeting to order at 1:00 pm and introduced the Board and staff.

Member Kohl moved to approve the April 11, 2019 minutes. Motion was seconded by Vice-Chair Denietolis. Motion carried.

Old Business

- **Extensions of Conditional Approvals**

Breton Bay Fine Wine & Spirits – Thomas McKay - Requesting 90 day extension of conditional approval

- **Application**

Mary Black and Lucas Black appeared before the Board and were sworn in. Mrs. Black stated that she had received the Traders license and the Use and Occupancy permit. Member Kohl made a motion for the approval. Motion was seconded by Vice-Chair Denietolis. Motion carried.

- **Special Privilege applications**

Quades Store – Sally Quade- Requesting temporary extension of premise for five (5) special outdoor music events from 5:00 PM to midnight on: 5/25/19, 7/27/19, 8/17/19, & 9/14/19 and noon to midnight on 6/29/19.

Sally Jo Quade appeared before the Board and was sworn in. Mrs. Quade explained the circumstances of the events, the security plans for the dock and crowd control. Member Kohl made a motion for the approval. Motion was seconded by Vice. Chair Denietolis. Motion carried.

Days Off Deli and Grill – Justin Keys - Requesting Catering privilege

Justin Keys appeared before the Board and was sworn in. Mr. Keys explained to the Board that he plans to purchase a box trailer and use it to cater alcohol with his catering food truck. It was explained to Mr. Keys that he cannot use the privilege as a vendor that it is for contracted catered events. Mr. Keys stated he understood. Member Kohl made a motion for the approval. Motion was seconded by Vice. Chair Denietolis. Motion carried.

- **Premise Changes**

Days Off Deli and Grill – Justin Keys- Requesting permanent extension of premise into 1925 square foot adjacent unit

Mr. Keys explained that he is planning to extend his original restaurant space into the next store space to add 1925 square feet to his restaurant. Member Trossbach made a motion for the 90 day conditional approval pending the Fire Marshal, Health Department, LUGM, and Use and Occupancy permit. Motion was seconded by Member Willenborg. Motion carried. Member Kohl made an amendment to the motion to include the finalization of the lease in the approvals. The amended motion was seconded by Member Willenborg. Motion carried.

- **Other Business**

Board Administrator – Tammy Hildebrand- Absent

Renewal summary- All licenses were renewed except Mad Moon.

June 13th ABB meeting- Discussion was made about what the procedure would be if the Chairman and Vice-Chairman were both absent for a meeting at the same time. Member Willenborg explained that he thought it would be the senior member of the Board would lead the meeting.

Alcohol Enforcement Coordinator – Sgt. Steve Myers- Absent

Chairman Hall presented the report for the month of April for Sgt. Myers as follows: 10 compliance checks- 0 violations; 11 tobacco compliance checks- 0 violations; 4 School Tobacco violations; 27 DUI arrests; 1 Cops Unit Violation and attended 4 meetings/trainings.

Board Inspector – Garland Thompson

Mr. Thompson stated for the month of April he inspected 16 establishments and had 1 follow-up.

St. Mary's Licensed Beverage Association- David Dent

Mr. Dent explained that new legislation was passed to increase the age of the tobacco sales from 18 years old to 21 years old that will take effect on October 1, 2019.

Community Alcohol Coalition – Mary Ellen Kraese

Mrs. Kraese stated that there is a conference sponsored by CAC on June 3rd for retailers and law enforcement. There will be a free Alcohol Awareness training offered and also an awards ceremony for all retailers who have had no violations in the last 3 years.
