

Personal Property Due Date

The due date for Personal Property accounts is September 30th each year. However, each account can file an extension for filing their return which can cause a different due date to be presented on the tax bill. In general, due dates are associated with the end of each month. Please check your bill for the appropriate due date.

To communicate with accounts more clearly, the following annotations may appear on a Personal Property tax bill.
