The park is not staffed during the weekdays. **There are no entrance fees during the week.**

Saturday, Sunday and Holidays: 8:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. The park is staffed during the **WEEKENDS AND HOLIDAYS. Entrance fees are charged on weekends and holidays.** (See fees below.)

Winter Months: December, January, February, March

Weekday and Weekend: The park gate is closed for vehicular traffic. You may walk in the park during these months. **No fees are charged at any time.**
